- What we have heard so far on these subjects has been positive and based on good premises
- These will now need to be refined as the project develops
- We also look forward to receiving the clarifications on the process for the Olympic Law
- And, if Milan-Cortina are awarded the Games, we will be happy to continue supporting the Italian team in analysing efficiencies for the alpine skiing events
- After our five days here, we can say that the overwhelming popular support demonstrated by the latest IOC poll is not a surprise
 - 83 per cent of Italy is in favour of a candidature
 - In the Region of Lombardy, we have 81 per cent, with 87 per cent in Milan
 - $\circ~$ And 80 per cent in the Region of Veneto
- It is clear for us that you can make dreams happen together
- Following our visits to the Candidate Cities, we now feel much more prepared to deliver an accurate and thorough report to my fellow IOC members
- They rely on this to make the best useful decision as they vote at the IOC Session in Lausanne on 24 June
