Stratified by gender, age and city of residence













ROME AND ITS CANDIDATURE TO 2024 OLYMPIC GAMES






Three out of four italians would like Rome to be the location chosen for 2024 Olympic Games



The opinion sentiment within SOCIAL NETWORKS

During the monitored time lapse, the opinion mood on the social media concerning Rome's candidature to 2024 Olympic Games was mainly positive (57%). Negative opinions are 22% of the total. 21% of contents do not express judgements, therefore they are neutral (they are mainly pieces of news).




Users' opinions mainly concern:

The **Rome 2024 event** (40%)

- The communication activity of the Committee (22%)
- The effects of the event on the country (11%)
- The city of Rome (11%)
- The Organizing Committee / Institutions (6%)
- The Italian Spirit (nationalism and country system)(5%)












THE MOST LOVED ATHLETS




Track-and-field and swimming are the most followed Olympic sports! Soccer, artistic gymnastic and volleyball come next

MAIN OUTCOMES

- Three out of four Italians are in favour of hosting international events: past events hosted by Italy have been perceived as an advantage for the Country.
- Three out of four Italians are in favour of the candidature, almost 70% in Rome; actually, one third of the citizens fears that some issues could arise for their city.
- The approval is mainly generated by the opportunities:
 - For Italy, the creation of jobs, and the chance to offer a positive image at international level;
 - For Rome, the chance to intervene on its infrastructures, improving the offer of services: Rome gains the trust of many people, who believe in the right and transparent management of the event.
- About 60% of people are aware of the Paralympic Games; it is important to them that they take place together with the Olympic Games. 3 out of 4 among those who are informed about the Paralympic Games state their interest, as well.
- Overall, the hosting of the Olympic Games is supported, they are widely considered as a chance rather than an issue, but it is worth mentioning that there is also one third of hesitating citizens of Rome.
- The communication of the event, even in this first stage, helps Olympic Games settle and generates approval. It would be best to talk about the opportunities for Italy as a whole and not only about the advantages for the city.
